The Tool Show, the UK's No 1 branded hand tool, power tool and machinery event, took place last month at Kempton Park Racecourse in Surrey. This year the show celebrated its 10th year and the unusually mild weather, combined with the usual free entry and free parking, ensured that the show was once again a well-attended success, with crowds able to enjoy the sunshine outside on the Friday and Sunday.

The leading brands in the industry were all represented, and several new names were exhibiting at the event for the first time. The show, which extended over two floors



as well featuring outside displays and a specially built marquee, showcased all the latest products. This was combined with exclusive show offers and deals, providing visitors with a unique opportunity to meet the manufacturers directly under one roof and to discuss their individual requirements in person.
