Makita KP0810K

The Makita is an impressive machine and remarkably has managed to slip into the mid-range bracket. It's supplied with a vast dustbag that can be fitted to either side of the machine. It has a comfortable soft-grip padded main handle and a large front handle that also sets the depth of cut.

The maximum depth of cut is a generous 4mm and the powerful motor is more than capable of delivering this. A solid side fence is included, as is a rebate depth stop. The alloy soleplate is beautifully finished with a

highly polished surface and three chamfering grooves in the front. There is a sprung plastic foot at the rear. Blade changing is simple and, unusually, the

Makita is supplied with a blade setting jig.

In use it is a great performer, powering along through the hardest timbers without complaint. The motor is extremely smooth and performance is faultless. This is an excellent tool.
