

## Festool CT Mini

'Careful, this is the David Beckham of the vacuum cleaning world' the lady editor warned me as she delivered the Festool to my testing laboratory.

This is a machine of smart appearance in ivory and green, a good-looking accessory for any workshop.

Caster wheels make the 9.5kg machine easy to manoeuvre and it came ready assembled for use.

But despite the price the accessories are extra, so you want a lot of performance for this amount of money.

The 1200W Festool can be used for wet and dry collection, has 10 litres capacity and came with a filter bag that must be removed for collecting liquid matter.

A socket is included for connecting electric tools to the cleaner, a handy addition for the workshop.

There is a stand/brake that

is useful for dust extraction as the cleaner stays in one place whilst working with power tools.

A useful extra on the Festool is a suction force regulator that can be adjusted according to the matter being collected. And even with the regulator on full this is a relatively quiet machine.

There is an antistatic system, so no nasty shocks for the operator. Suction is good and it is pleasant to work with, weighing 9.5kg.

But in my opinion you could get just the same performance for less money.
